




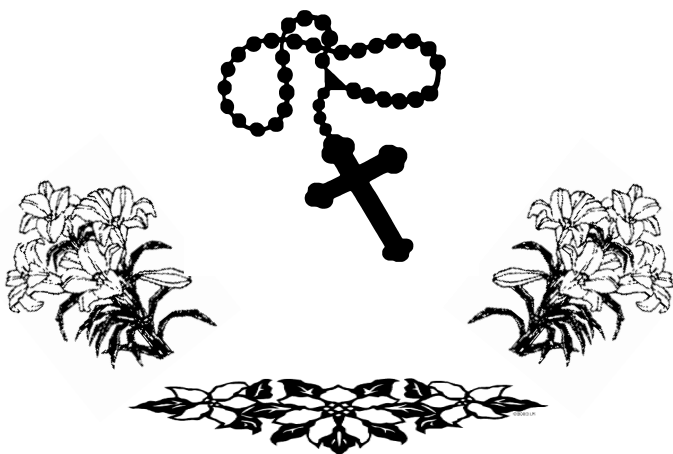

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, and in fact for the next three years, we are invited to rediscover and keep alive the "Eucharistic amazement" Pope Saint John Paul II always taught is at the center of Catholic and Christian life and sensibility. We begin with a Eucharistic procession at 3:15 PM Sunday, an apt remembrance of the Eucharistic procession in France that began the conversion of Antoinette Margot, our foundress, and we "double down" on all the opportunities available for Eucharistic Adoration and Confession here in the parish. We do this, confident that this work that God began in our midst in "covid" time was the blessing He intends for the flourishing of our parish.

As we rediscovered and celebrated at our Town Hall Style Parish Council meeting on Saturday, May 12th, only the parish is organized around the Eucharist, though other Church entities, of course, can celebrate it. Being organized around the Eucharist, as many and as diverse as we are, will have to guide our reflections as we recover from the disruptions of the last two years. Certainly our parish would not exist without all the faithful who found Jesus here at Eucharistic Adoration, and in his presence, reconciliation through the sacrament of confession. We hope they will stay, and others will join, for the "Divine Renovation" only the Eucharist can provide.

As providence has it, "Rediscovering Eucharistic Wonder" was the topic of a homily Rainiero Cardinal Cantalamessa preached to the papal household last Lent. He reminds us that the Eucharist, far from being an escape from the drama of "wars and rumors of war" in which we live, in fact allows us to understand and participate in them from the perspective of the Eucharist, which is the "presence in history of the event that has forever reversed the roles of victors and victims." As Jesus says: "Have courage: I have conquered the world!" (John 16:33). Be amazed!

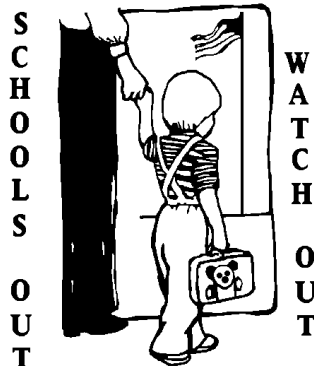
